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COVID-19 Screening & Quarantine Policy

Kops 4 Kids will use the following screening practices for admittance into the facility for the Kops 4 Kids program. Parents are to complete a COVID-19 checklist each morning at home before they send their child(ren) to Kops 4 Kids. Please follow the instructions on the checklist to determine whether your child(ren) needs to stay home. An advisor will screen the child(ren) at the door for any visible symptoms of COVID-19. If any COVID-19 symptoms are displayed the child will not be admitted into the facility.

Any child(ren) who has been exposed to COVID-19 will be quarantined in accordance with the CDC quarantine guidelines. Any child(ren) pending a COVID-19 test result will not be admitted into the facility. The child(ren) may return to the facility the day after a negative test result. If the test result is positive, the child(ren) will follow CDC quarantine guidelines. Quarantine guidelines provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regarding exposures will be followed.

Kops 4 Kids will also follow the CDC's recommendations for quarantining regarding travel. As of September 2, 2021, all non-vaccinated individuals will have to quarantine for 10 days when traveling domestically within the United States and internationally. Anyone who is fully vaccinated need not quarantine. During any quarantine it is recommended to self-monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19.
